## The Clark Humanities Museum - Treasures of Asian Arts at Scripps College

Over the years, Scripps College has been the beneficiary of a fascinating variety of Asian art collections ranging from cloisonné, ceramics, lacquer ware, woodblock prints and paintings. Bruce Coats, Ph.D., Scripps College Professor of Art History and the Humanities, and Director of the Clark Humanities Museum, shared slides of the works housed in this collection in his presentation to the AAC in January. We will be viewing what he presented. In addition to the works on display, Dr. Coats has offered a special treat to share with us some of the works typically housed in storage.



## The Ruth Chandler Williamson Gallery- Amazing Images: Japanese Prints at Scripps College

The Ruth Chandler Williamson Gallery stewards a rich array of Asian art: including a superb collection of Japanese prints from the 15<sup>th</sup> through the 21st centuries. We will be viewing these amazing Japanese woodblock prints.



## Ramos Martinez 100 ft Murals in the Margaret Fowler Memorial Garden

Scripps College commissioned Ramos Martinez in 1946 to create this extraordinary mural, "The Flower Vendors," his most ambitious project. He sketched in the entire composition on the plaster wall, which is over 100 feet long, and then began work on several panels. Unexpectedly, he became ill and died on November 8, 1946 at the age of 72. What remains is a riveting work-in-progress frozen in time. It is a great mural for us to understand the fresco process in its unfinished state, showing the master's techniques at different stages. The entire mural was analyzed and conserved in 1994 with a grant from the Getty Endowment."
