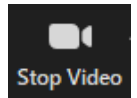
Welcome, Meeting, Lecture – Everyone will be Muted

**When to enter the meeting? AAC members begin being admitted at 12:40, Guests at 12:50 p.m.**

Taking a break? *Stop Video* when your video Square will be distracting. Leaving the meeting and re-entering distracts the speaker, but if leaving for good Press the red *Leave* button in the lower right hand corner above the Zoom menu bar.
